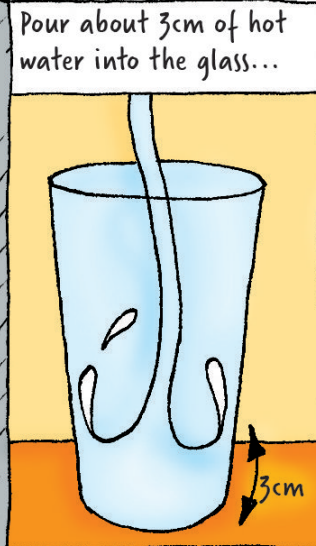
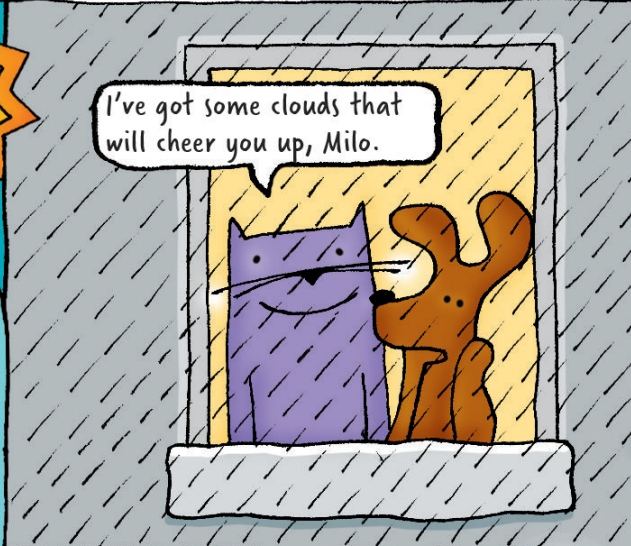


**DO TRY THIS AT HOME**

• Hot water • Ice • Aerosol spray (e.g. deodorant)

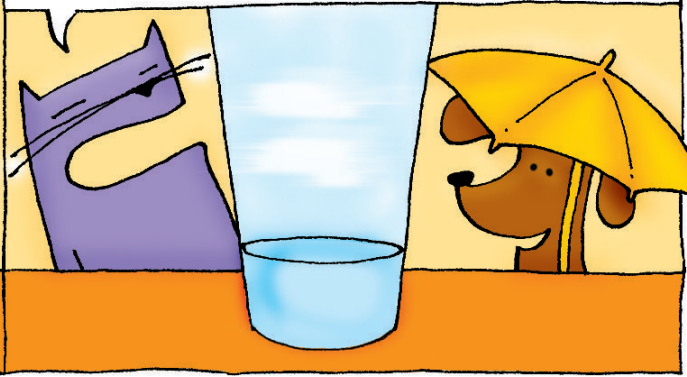


Put the ice in the small bowl and balance the bowl on top of the glass.

Lift the bowl and spray some deodorant into the glass, replacing the bowl quickly afterwards.
